#BuiltWithBitcoin

Paxful launched the #BuiltWithBitcoin charitable initiative in 2017 to show that bitcoin can help people around the world.

With the goal to build 100 schools, water wells, and community gardens for sustainable agriculture funded entirely by bitcoin all across Africa, the initiative showcases the capability of charity and philanthropy within the crypto industry.

To date, we have built two schools - a nursery, and a primary school in Rwanda, Africa- and provided scholarships to Afghan refugees.

We encourage the cryptocurrency sector to contribute more to humanitarian projects. The #BuiltWithBitcoin initiative is an example of bitcoin being used as more than a speculative tool but a testament to the usefulness of cryptocurrency.

Our First School Built with Bitcoin

In partnership with ZamZam Water, we completed the construction of a nursery school in **Kasebigege Village, Rwanda**. The nursery school has **three classrooms**, a **portable irrigation system with four lavatories**, and a **15,000-liter water system**.

The project benefits children between the ages of three to six in a village of 7,500 people. The project also includes a farm, which will encourage sustainable agriculture for the whole village.



Scholarship Program for Afghan Refugees

As part of the expansion of the #BuiltWithBitcoin initiative, we granted more than **\$15,000** in scholarships to help female Afghan refugees pursue their careers in the U.S.

The scholarship recipients are **Susan Naseri**, who is interested in non-profit work and law; **Dunia Azizi**, who will pursue a mathematics degree; and **Farzana Nawabi**, who is working towards a bachelor's degree in nursing.



Primary School for 300 students

Through our continued partnership with the people of ZamZam Water, we are building another school in Rwanda dedicated for students between the ages of 6 to 15 that started in 2018.

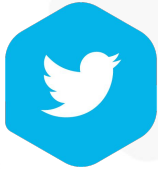
The school will be **twice the size** of the first one with 6 classrooms, cafeteria, bathroom stalls, solar panels, and 35,000L water system.
